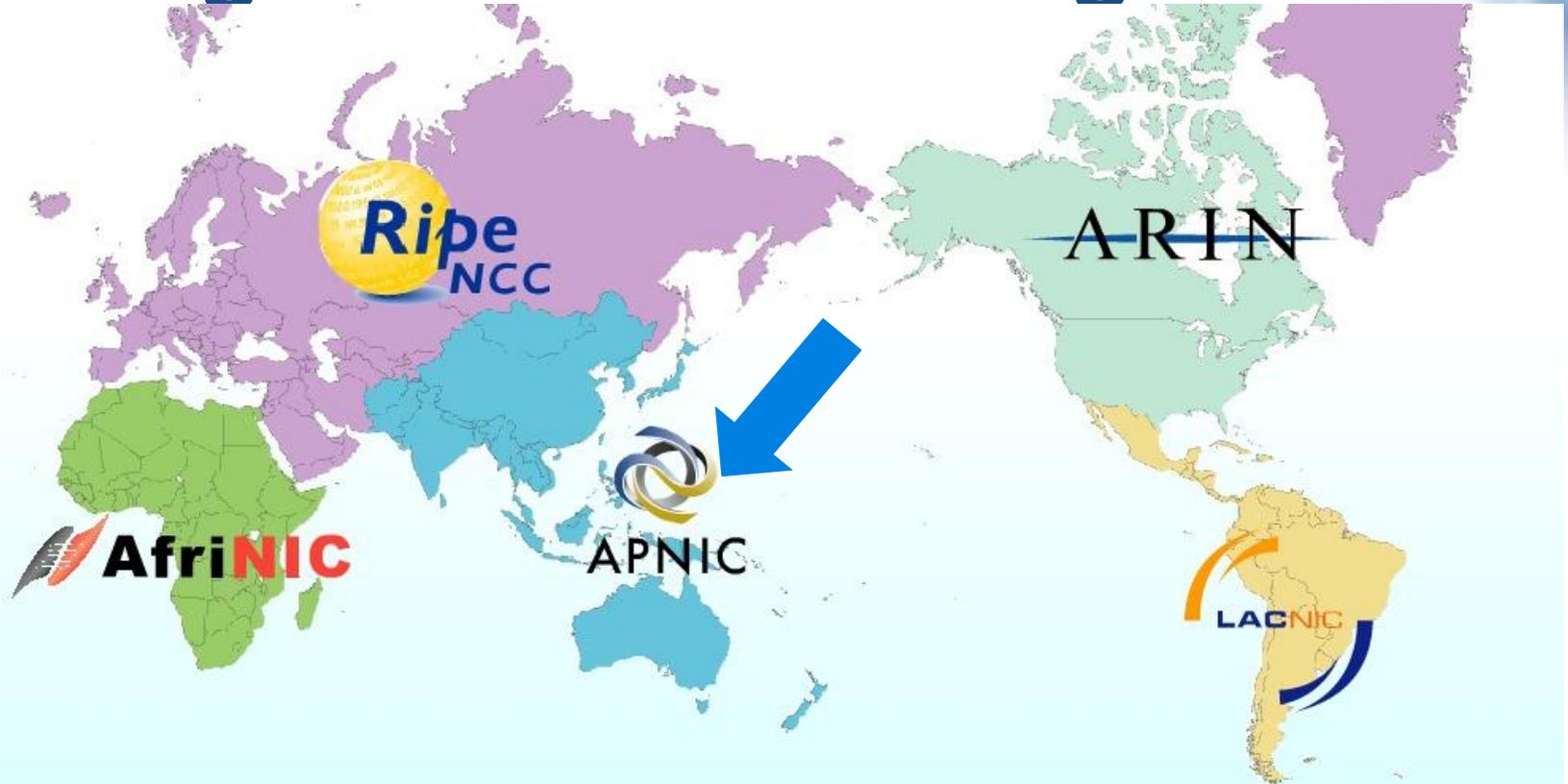

The Internet community established the RIRs to provide fair and consistent resource distribution and accurate resource registration throughout the world.

Internet Resource Management Objectives

Conservation

- Efficient use of resources
- Based on demonstrated need

Aggregation

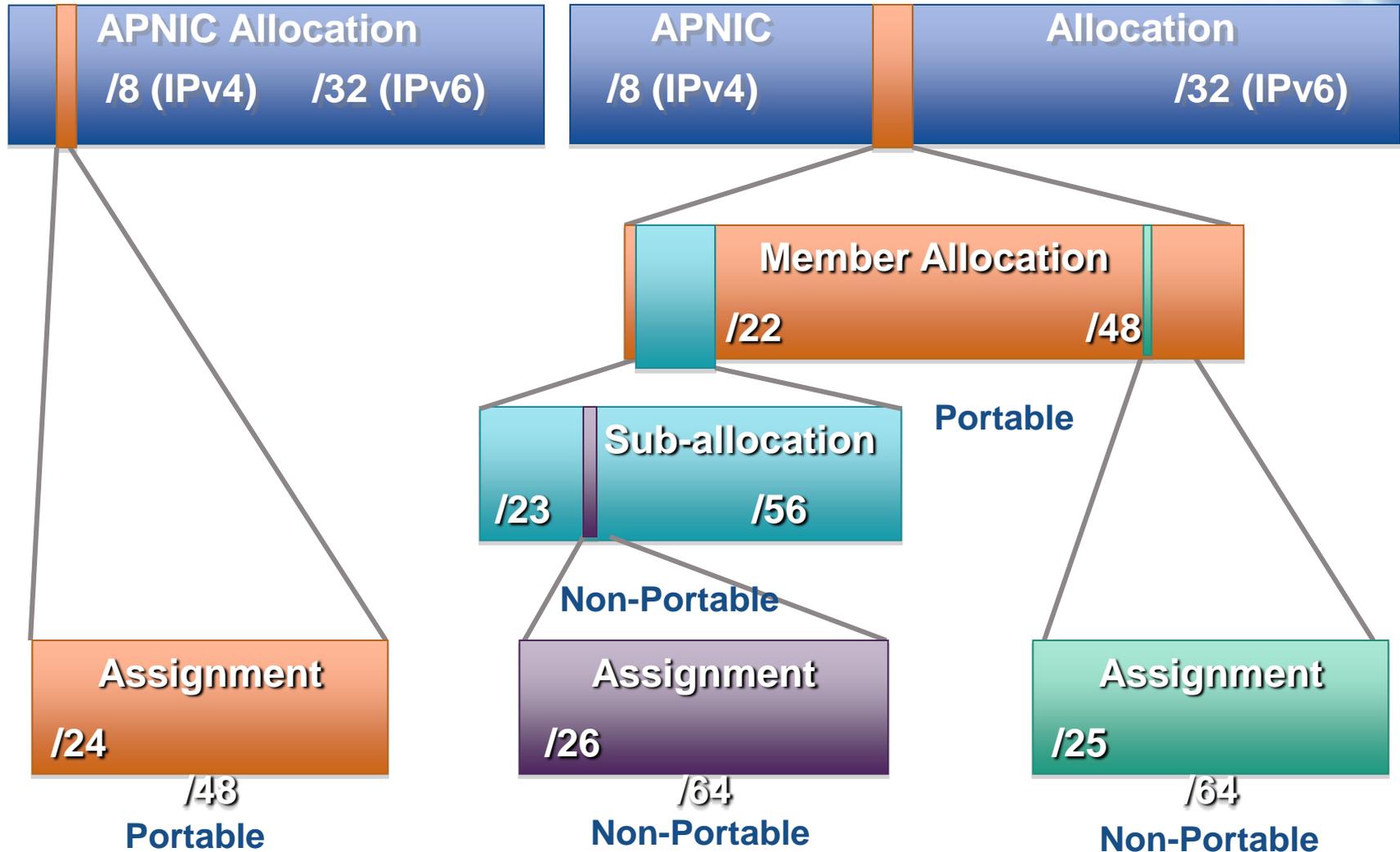
- Limit routing table growth
- Support provider-based routing

Registration

- Ensure uniqueness
- Facilitate trouble shooting

Uniqueness, fairness and consistency

IP Address Management Hierarchy



- Describes “portability” of the address space

Initial IPv6 Address/ASN Request

- You are required to be an IDNIC/APNIC member in order to initiate your IP Address Request.
- To qualify for a portable IP, you must:
 - Be a provider (Telco, ISP, Data center, i.e. sub-delegates IP address to customers)
 - Or
 - Have a multi-homing network (connection to IX and upstream/multiple upstream)
